
QHVSG Support

The QHVSG Support focus will provide:

- Grief Support
 - First responder
 - Care Pack (information on what to do)
 - Court Support
- Peer Support
 - One on one support
 - Support meetings
 - Social events



Support Model





- Area Coordinators (former Team Leaders) located across Queensland
- Healthy support groups established across Queensland
- Area Coordinators manual (to define a consistent model)
- Support Member packs (for each support role) to engage members
- Established peer to peer support structure (formal & social)
- Facilitated transition between New Member and Active Member
- A grief and trauma specialist for children
- Support activities for specific demographics
 - children, men, Indigenous, Islander
- Full-time staff in the office to be first responders
- Full-time staff in the office to provide consistent support services



- Continue to provide current support mechanism that we do today.
- Engage with the broader membership
- Re-establish contact with those that have not been active
- Develop the Area Coordinator training manual and meeting pack
- Develop volunteer packs for each support role
- Identify future support locations
- Begin recruiting Area Coordinators
- Encourage active members to become a supporting member
- Begin developing specific programs
 - age, gender, cultural



QHVSG Education

The QHVSG Education focus will provide:

- Awareness and Training
 - Detective training
 - Media training
 - Member education
 - Public awareness
- Research
 - Understand existing laws and changes
 - Identify new law requirements
 - Homicide statistics and information



- Widely available range of education programs and materials
- Community awareness in target markets
- The 'Go To' organisation for Homicide in Queensland
- Media influencing (journalists, producers, editors, training institutions)
- Establish connections with external people and organisations
 - University research projects
- On the pulse for statistics and information regarding homicide and its effects
- New 'foundations' or 'call to support' to be done in conjunction with QHVSG



- Release an awareness campaign with Members to showcase QHVSG services
- Develop a research group to begin gathering homicide statistics and information
- Review the detective training program
- Develop a media training program
- Partnership with other organisations on anti-violence and support services
- Annual survey / feedback of members
- Develop awareness material showing homicide information and statistics
- Develop partnerships with educational institutions and agencies
- Develop a program to assist members to host remembrance tributes



QHVSG Reform

The QHVSG Reform focus will provide:

- Legislative Review
- Case Advocacy (specific individual issues)
- Systems Advocacy (systemic process issues)



- Members have an avenue to raise issues for QHVSG to act on their behalf
 - ie Dept of Corrections, Parole Board, Police, etc
- Public forum to debate 'issues' related to homicide
- Specific homicide topics actively pursued

Examples

- No body no parole
- Truth in sentencing for consecutive sentences
- Child protection from convicted murderers
- Successfully championed for a Commissioner for Crime
- QC to represent Homicide victims



- Develop a communication conduit for members to request assistance
- Develop a mechanism to redirect to staff where an immediate response is required to provide assistance and be the conduit to victim services, liaise with members and deliver an outcome
- Establish sub-groups to focus on specific law reform initiatives
- Develop relationships with the relevant top 100 influencers relating to law reform
- Generate a regular platform for regular discussion with members, support services, justice and politicians on issues relating to homicide



QHVSG Communication

The QHVSG Communication focus will provide:

- Internal
 - Membership communication
- External Communication
 - Networking with other organisations
 - Engagement of influence brokers
- All
 - Event and activities information
 - Communications templates
 - Media releases
- Online
 - Coordination of the websites and social media



- Standard templates for communications
- Client Relationship Management software
 - Isolation between support & event contact information
 - Online financial transactions
- Fully on-line environment
- Social Media presence, chat rooms
- Shared secured site for members / board / etc
- Engagement with affiliated organisations and their services
 - ie Daniel Morecombe foundation, Bravehearts, DV Connect, etc
- Engaged top 100 influence brokers with a formal ongoing communications strategy
- Sponsorship packs



- Develop communication strategies for internal event packs and demographics
- Setup a fully operational online presence
 - Review web site capabilities and content
 - Review social media content
 - Allocate people responsible
- Identify end engage with the top 100 influencers brokers
- Identify and document details for affiliated organisations
- Investigate and implement Client Relationship Management (CRM) software



QHVSG Funding

The QHVSG Funding focus will provide:

- Funding Submissions
 - Government
 - Partnerships with other agencies or organisations
- Fundraising
 - Review and advise on legal requirements for fundraising
- Budgeting
 - Financial Reporting
 - Expenditure review



- Information pack for anyone raising funds for QHVSG
- Group of people dedicated to writing funding submissions
- Bequest program / Memorial fund
- Transparent financial reporting for Board, members and funding bodies
 - Financial dashboard
 - Financial reports
- Demarcation between Government funded and group funded activities



- Creation of a fundraising information pack
- Identify 100 funding sources that are applicable to QHVSG
- Engage volunteers to write funding submissions
- Develop succinct financial dashboard for the Board and members
 - Identify cost savings
 - Understand where money is being spent
- Develop processes to create budget items for region specific fundraising and activities expenditure
